Editorial Note :

It's Not How Big You Have Become, but How You Become Big

Dear Friend,

I recently heard this powerful statement from Mr. Anand Mahindra in an interview: “It’s not how big you have become, but how you become big.”

It struck a deep chord within me.

What truly defines an organization is not just its scale or numbers, but the value systems it pursues and upholds. At Unnati, over the years, we have consciously tried to manage our affairs by staying rooted in our core values. This commitment has helped us far beyond merely showcasing intent—it has enabled us to maintain quality, compliance, fairness, and real impact.

At no point of time have we chosen shortcuts or compromised on our values to achieve faster results, instead, we invested in processes, strengthened systems, and scaled responsibly. This approach has shaped who we are today.

As we enter the final quarter of the financial year—a quarter that will close our annual numbers—we are working towards two significant milestones.

First, we are hoping to reach 2 lakh youth across 14 states, primarily from underprivileged backgrounds—students studying in government colleges, from rural areas and Tier 2, 3, and 4 regions, including SC, ST, and OBC communities.

Second, we are approaching a cumulative impact of half a million youth over 22+ years of Unnati’s journey.

The true impact of the 2 lakh youth we are reaching this year will be seen in FY 2026–27, when we aim to ensure that over 80,000 of them are gainfully employed after graduation.

This has been a tough year for Unnati. As I write this note, we are still running a significant deficit. We are hopeful that the last quarter will help bridge this gap through CSR support.

Why then are we taking on more than we can chew?

It's a fair question.

The answer lies in a sense of responsibility—and yes, even guilt. If we restrict our numbers because the work is harder or resources are stretched, we feel we are letting down the youth, the future of our country, and the nation itself.

Unnati’s exponential growth over the years has been driven by the firm belief that when intentions are right and the purpose is good, the universe finds ways to support you. We

therefore call upon the collective goodness of everyone associated with Unnati—to stand by us, refer us to CSR partners, and help us achieve our shared goals.

January will mark another proud moment. Unnati will become the first organization in the country to be listed on the Social Stock Exchange for the third time. This is not just about raising funds—it is about demonstrating our unwavering commitment to compliance, transparency, documentation, and measurable impact. With fewer than 20 NGOs listed nationwide, and none having done it twice, this milestone should make every supporter of Unnati feel proud to be part of this movement.

One of our biggest challenges continues to be keeping our teams motivated and anchored to doing the right things every day. Each time a young person gets a job because of the training and transformation they receive, the nation moves a step forward. How do we help our teams see this work not merely as a job that pays a salary, but as a responsibility and a calling?

While motivation and inspiration are often discussed, I firmly believe that sustained commitment comes from the strength of the value systems we inherently possess. Let us awaken that within ourselves and continue to do good—not for validation, but because it brings purpose and happiness.

Wishing you and your loved ones a very Happy New Year, and looking forward to walking together into another impactful year ahead. We also encourage those who are able to volunteer—whether through time, skills, or mentoring—to join us in strengthening our work and amplifying the impact for the youth we serve.

Overall, the session was engaging and impactful, fostering a sense of belonging and commitment among the participants.


