Editorial Note:

2026–27: A Year of Purpose and Possibility

Dear Patrons,

Chapter 8, Shloka 8 of the *Bhagavad Gita* speaks about training the mind through steady practice—remaining focused on a single goal without distraction. Such unwavering focus helps us rise above challenges and move closer to our highest aspirations.

As I reflect on Unnati's journey over the last 23 years, I realise that this has been the guiding principle behind everything we have done. Our purpose has remained unchanged: every youth who comes to Unnati must become employable, and wherever possible, we help him or her secure meaningful employment. Since our inception, nearly five lakh young people have been trained through our programmes, with around three lakh of them entering the workforce. Many others have chosen different paths, pursuing higher education, entrepreneurship, family responsibilities or other life opportunities. Even for those of us who dreamt of building this programme, the scale is humbling. It reminds us that when the intent is right, we often become instruments of something much larger than ourselves.

It has been an immensely fulfilling journey, and I remain confident that as long as our intent remains pure, we will continue to find the strength to move forward. This year, however, has brought its own set of challenges. Global uncertainties, including the impact of ongoing conflicts, have affected funding, while rising costs have placed considerable pressure on our cash flows. Yet, experience has taught us one simple truth: *this too shall pass*. It always has.

We now look forward to **Utsav**, beginning on 15th August, when we will once again reach out to all of you to share our journey, our challenges, our achievements and our aspirations. More importantly, we will seek your continued support. I understand that time is precious, but I sincerely hope you will spare a few minutes to connect with us. There is nothing quite like a personal interaction. The Social Stock Exchange is also gathering momentum. The recent announcement permitting up to 10% of CSR allocations through the SSE has the potential to significantly strengthen organisations like Unnati. This calls for a shift in mindset and a conscious decision by CSR leaders to support this ecosystem. There may be many reasons to hesitate, but there is one compelling reason to participate—the opportunity to contribute meaningfully to nation building.

The SSE promotes the highest standards of governance, compliance, transparency and independently audited impact measurement. In many ways, it represents

outcome-based funding, ensuring that every rupee invested is linked to measurable social outcomes.

For 2026–27, Unnati has set itself an ambitious goal of enabling 50,000 young people to join the workforce with verifiable proof of employment. It is a formidable challenge, but meaningful goals are rarely easy. If these 50,000 youth earn even an average annual income of ₹1.5 lakh each, they would collectively add nearly ₹750 crore to our economy every year. That is the scale of value creation we aspire to contribute this financial year.

We will continue to work with diligence, purpose and determination. At the same time, we hope to expand our reach by bringing more committed office bearers into the Unnati family. A separate communication regarding this initiative will reach you shortly.

Thank you for your continued trust, encouragement and support. Together, let us continue building opportunities, transforming lives and strengthening our nation—one young person at a time.
