Title to the article - A Cry That Must Be Heard

Over the years, we have been blessed with a wonderful group of donors and patrons who have stood by Unnati with faith and generosity. Your continued support has been the backbone of our journey. However, in recent times, we have noticed a sharp decline in our collections — and it has become a matter of serious concern.

In a discussion with a few well-wishers and experts, one question stood out: How often do you reach out to your donors and patrons?

Our honest answer was — only a few times a year. Their response was simple yet striking: "The baby that cries the most gets the milk." In our quiet dignity and hesitation to ask too often, perhaps we missed this truth.

This year, we face considerable expenses, especially towards much-needed **repairs and renovations** at the Unnati Centre. After nearly two decades of continuous use, the premises require urgent attention — fixing leakages, painting, and restoring our infrastructure to ensure safety and efficiency. Unfortunately, while CSR funds support operational costs, they seldom cover repairs or maintenance.

We reach out personally to many of our supporters, and most express genuine willingness to help. But somewhere, our **follow-ups have fallen short**. Many may still be waiting for that gentle reminder from us — a nudge to act on their intent to contribute. Out of politeness or discomfort, we hesitate to ask again. That's our first mistake.

The second, and perhaps more serious, one is that our silence might have been misunderstood — it may have created the impression that we are doing fine and can manage without help this year. Nothing could be farther from the truth. Every rupee you contribute makes a real difference, and without your support, we cannot move ahead with these essential repairs.

Our **Gokulashtami series** this year was a celebration of devotion and artistry — with eminent and promising artistes performing and lifting our spirits. It was a reminder of how much beauty and purpose can be created when communities come together.

As we prepare to celebrate **Deepavali**, the festival of light and renewal, we seek your help once again — this time to **restore and strengthen Unnati's infrastructure**. This effort will enable us to reach out to nearly **two lakh youth** across our various centres and through **UNXT** in **14 states** during this financial year.

Sometimes we wonder if we are pushing ourselves too hard. But then we are reminded of the words of Hungarian Nobel laureate **László Krasznahorkai**, who said,

"I am very sad if I think of the state of the world, and this is my deepest inspiration."

That sadness — the sight of unemployed, underprepared youth — is what drives us to do more, to reach further, and to keep believing in change.

As we light our lamps this Deepavali, may we also rekindle hope — for the youth, for their families, and for our shared future.

Your contribution this festive season will help us rebuild, renew, and continue our mission with greater strength.



Harshika Sheshrao More, a determined young woman from a humble background in Bangalore, had a strong desire to improve her life and support her family. With a dream of becoming independent




